We are beginning to enforce the use of the numbered name tags in the nurseries on Sunday mornings now. This is important for parents and all members on the nursery rotation to be aware of. When a parent signs their child in, half of the name tag goes on the child's back, while the parent keeps the other half. At the end of the service, the nursery worker needs to ask for this half of the nursery sticker (and make sure the numbers match up) in order for the parent to take their child from the nursery. Nursery captains will be around to assist with these new changes. While we know this takes more time for parents and nursery workers, we feel this is necessary for the safety of our children and hope that everyone will cooperate with the procedure.
