### Unseen Benefits of Dogged Persistence

On April 15th, members of the CEFF team joined a call with one of China's leading Christian educators. This former pastor and current professor is currently the key figure behind a herculean effort to re-establish a network of Christian colleges and universities across China. Of course, because of Communist Party persecution, these "illegal" efforts are fraught with difficulty and risk. In fact, the former leader of this project is suffering in a Chinese prison today.

Although the purpose of the call was to discuss CEFF's role in an upcoming conference of Christian educators inside of China, as our time drew to a close this remarkable man suddenly said, "I want to thank you for your dogged persistence in the work of Christian, classical education for Chinese families. CEFF's example of perseverance over the past years has been a catalyst in bringing together the team of 10 men and women who will make this important meeting a reality."
